Fremont Catholic Schools Collaboration Up-Date

Yesterday, October 22nd, the pastors and principals of the three Fremont parishes met with the hired facilitator, Carol Collins, to make a decision on continuing participation in the steering committee's short term process. Each pastor had been asked to meet with parish leadership to determine the consensus recommendation and prepare their decision to be discussed at the pastor/principal meeting.

At Sacred Heart we had met with all advisory councils (Parish Council, School Advisory Council, Finance Council), and Fr. Bill created an additional Ad Hoc Committee that included parishioners who had been active in previous steering committee endeavors. The resounding recommendation was that Sacred Heart has a keen interest in the outcome and wishes to be active in the future with long-term action planning for Catholic Schools in Fremont. Fr. Bill, pastor at Sacred Heart stated, "While Sacred Heart Church remains committed to dialogue about the greater vision of Catholic education and its structures in Fremont, we in the end determined that it would not be advisable for us to enter into a conclusive commitment to an open-ended process with many unknown variables and an unknown outcome."

At present St. Joseph and St. Ann Elementary Schools will be proceeding on a process involving their 2 schools. Sacred Heart School will continue as is, and will be solely responsible for our school's future.
