The card comes loaded with \$5 and is reloadable at the store. You receive dollar-for-dollar the amount you pay for. Sacred Heart cards can be used where ever there is a Kroger store, so relatives and friends can help our school even if they do not live locally. Kroger Cares

Gift Card Program

- You can recharge your card. However, you have to PAY FOR YOUR RECHARGE FIRST. There must be two transactions, one to reload the card and another to purchase your items.
- Always leave at least a dollar on your card. A card with \$0.00 balance for a period of 90 days will be taken out of the system. A new card then needs to be purchased.
- A card purchased in a store CANNOT be linked to our school. Please buy from us.
- Your card can be used for anything in the Kroger stores except for services. Services include: money orders, Western Union, lottery tickets, hunting/fishing licenses and Ticket Master.
- You can always find the balance on your card by looking at the bottom of your latest receipt or calling 1-866-822-6252. (The number is on the back of the card.)
- The gift card is accepted in all Kroger Stores throughout the U. S. and can be sent to family and friends out of state.... as long as they reload their card.
