## CREED

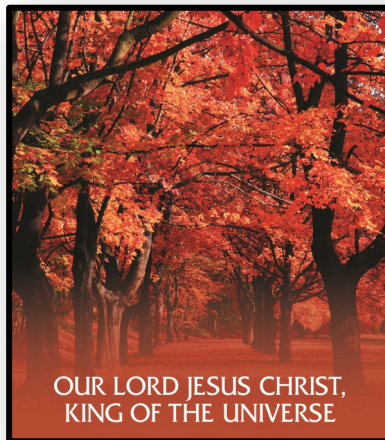
**Bridge:** Name above all names, worthy of all praise. My heart will sing: How great is our God! (repeat)
