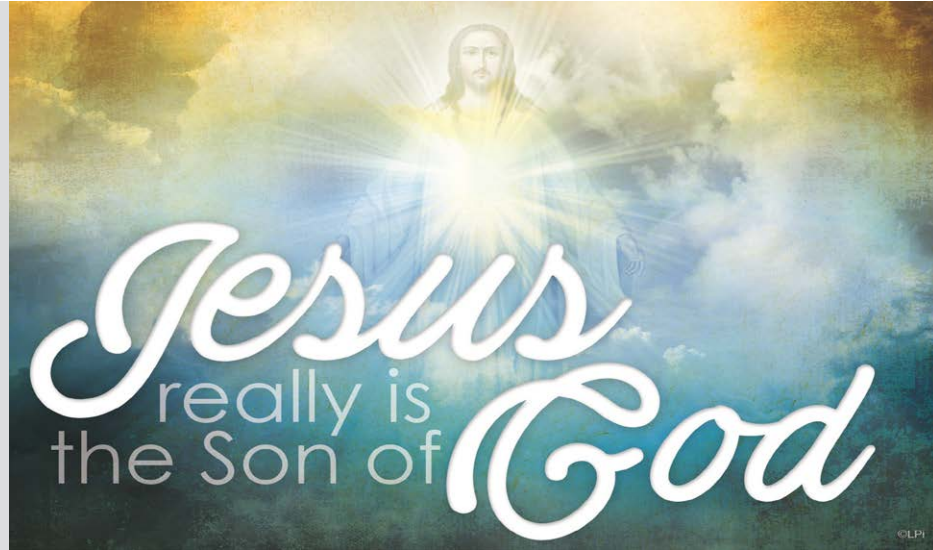

We are so glad to have you here with us today.*



Dear Friends,

We are faced in today's readings with a paradox of our Christian faith - we belong here *and* we do not belong here. It is in this world and through this world that we are to find our God. Yet, this is not our permanent home. We are pilgrims on a journey to a more permanent dwelling place, a place of total union with our God of Truth and Love. That is the goal of living and we need to keep it constantly before our eyes. It is so easy to get obsessed with things on the way: our career, our financial security, education of our children, or the house we want. The list can go on without end. These are small stepping stones to a life beyond. Life, as someone put it, is like watching a movie in a cinema. One cannot cry out: "Stop! I want to stay in this scene!" No, a movie goes on. And life goes on. It is important to know where life is heading and which road to follow. There are so many roads and people who want us to follow them. We need someone who can show us the way, someone who leads us on the path to fullness of life. "This Someone" is Jesus Christ, but we need to meet Him and follow Him. Has each one of us truly met Jesus on a personal level? We have to in order to follow Him.

There is a story about two monks having conversation. A young monk asked an older monk, "Why do so many come here to join the monastery, but after a short time they give up the effort to be a monk, and leave?" The old monk thought for a while, and answered, "Sometimes as you stand here in front of the monastery, you will see a rabbit pass by chased by the village dogs, barking and howling. After some time, the rabbit comes back, but there are only one or two dogs in pursuit. These are the dogs that actually saw the rabbit, the other dogs were following the barking. Likewise, if we are to persevere in the monastery and live as monks, we must have a glimpse of the rabbit - of the Lord - and not just be following the barking."

The Transfiguration is one of those moments of seeing Jesus as God's Son, and not just hearing about Him from others, but having a personal encounter with Him. As long as we hear about Jesus, but never really meet Him or experience His unconditional love and mercy we will struggle to follow Him. We can even stop following Him all together. Jesus takes Peter, James and John up a high mountain. Suddenly, Jesus glows. His clothes become whiter than any bleach could get them, an inner light radiating out from Christ. Peter, James and John saw Jesus as the Lord. They realized there is someone to listen to and someone to follow. Ask yourself a simple question - have I met Jesus or have I just heard about Him?

May you continue to have a blessed Lent,

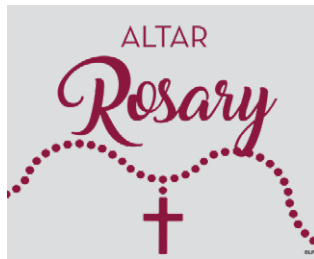





# Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

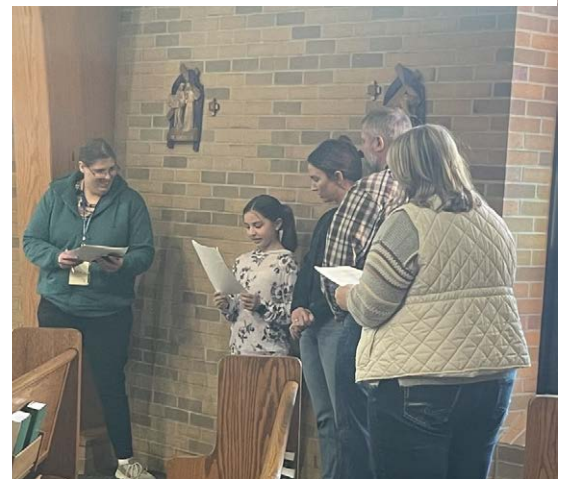

**Dispensation from Lenten Abstinence on Friday, 17 March 2023**


Out of pastoral solicitude, Bishop Daniel Thomas has dispensed the faithful of the Diocese of Toledo, whether actually present in the territory or not, from the obligation to abstain from meat on the memorial of Saint Patrick, Bishop, which will be observed this year on Friday, March 17. Catholics present in the Diocese of Toledo who otherwise reside in another diocese, are likewise dispensed. No member of the faithful is required to make use of this dispensation. Those who choose to make use of this dispensation are strongly encouraged to abstain from meat on some other day that week as part of their penitential practices during Lent. In this way, a faithful Catholic still keeps the penitential spirit of a Friday in Lent and unites oneself more closely with the suffering Christ and His Church.
