WELCOME...to any new parishioners and to those visiting. We are so glad to have you here with us today.



The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord brought the liturgical season of Christmas to a close. In this beautiful image, we reflect on the Gospel moment of Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan by John the Baptist, which marked the beginning of His public ministry. Following His Baptism, Jesus sets out to teach, preach, heal and save. His earthly ministry that begins in these waters will culminate on the glorious morning of His Resurrection and continue through His presence in the Eucharist.

In this image, we also see a manifestation of Jesus' divine Sonship and a public proclamation of His saving mission. The Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, descends with rays of light on Jesus. In scripture, we hear the voice of His heavenly Father saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Mt 3: 17).

Every Christian is called, by virtue of Baptism, to a life of ongoing conversion, loving witness to the Gospel, and perseverance in prayer. We are able to live out this baptismal vocation at home, in the workplace and in our communities. The joy, humility, perseverance and courage that marks our witness to the Gospel is rooted in graces first received at Baptism. At our Baptism, we were incorporated into the mystery of God: the Father, Son and Holy Spirit (the Trinity) in whose name we are baptized.

The grace of Baptism is not a thing of the past, a sacramental memory from infancy or childhood. Rather, it is the foundation of a new life lived daily in the light of God's love and mercy. Let us strive to have an awareness of the gift of God's abundant graces, first received at our own Baptism.


