WELCOME...to any new parishioners and to those visiting. We are so glad to have you here with us today.

Dear Friends,

This weekend, we begin our 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). This year's theme is "This Is The Day!" This diocesan appeal funds a variety of ministries, services, and agencies that assist parishes and parishioners throughout our 19-county diocese. The generosity of our parish is a sign of our strong faith. I ask you to join me to prayerfully consider your financial support of essential programs and services financed by ACA. Here are some of the ministries supported by the Annual Catholic Appeal:



- 1. **Diocesan Priestly Vocations.** The purpose of this department is to help with an individual's process of discernment to determine whether the Lord is calling them to serve in the Church. Seminarians are educated, formed to provide the sacraments, and preach the Gospel for years and generations to come. It costs approximately \$35,000 per year per seminarian. Most men are in the seminary for an average of 6 years before they are ordained to the priesthood. Without support, we would not be able to provide the education for the seminarians and thus continue staffing our parishes with Priests.
- 2. **Catholic Charities'** mission is "To make real the love of God for every individual person regardless of their faith or background by serving the poor, speaking for and assisting the neglected and forgotten, respecting and promoting life from beginning to end and nurturing and supporting individuals and families." Every year they help more than 45,000 people.
- 3. **Permanent Deacons**. There are 182 permanent deacons serving the Diocese of Toledo. Currently, there are 26 men in the Deacon Formation program. They meet one weekend each month in prayer, academic study, and fellowship at the Pines Retreat Center in Fremont, Ohio. There are four pillars of formation; human, spiritual, intellectual, and Pastoral
- 4. Catechetical Formation. The Catholic Education Department supports the work of our parishes, schools and educators in passing on the practices of our Catholic Faith from Pre-K through adult. This department provides specialized formation for the religious education leaders, teachers and catechists of the Diocese. The Catholic Education Department also supports school leaders and administrators by providing training, formation and leadership. The Department actively advocates for Catholic Schools at the state legislative and policy levels.
- 5. Office for Life equips the church through seminars, presentations, and training to defend human life from the womb to the tomb. They offer pregnancy intervention, including the training and equipping of sidewalk counselors who reach out to mothers and fathers in an unintended pregnancy. Project Rachel invites all who have been involved in abortion to experience the reconciliation and the mercy of God. All who seek compassionate, nonjudgmental help can encounter God's mercy, healing, and love.

This weekend, February 18/19, is Commitment Weekend for the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal. If you are registered with the parish, you should have already received a letter regarding this vital appeal. Our parish goal is \$41,566. I encourage you to join me in supporting our Annual Catholic Appeal. The ministries it supports are a source of hope to many in our Diocese.


